

Social Media Policy

WMCC will continue to develop and maintain its own online social media presence through Facebook and our Website. We will use social media to share information and promote achievements within our club.

Our public reputation is valuable. We prohibit any communication on social media that is defamatory and offensive towards other players, umpires and sponsors, and/or misrepresentative of WMCC.

Positive social media

We encourage positive posts from all it's members on game day progress, photos of participation, social experiences, and messages to congratulate members.

A member of the WMCC Committee will post upcoming events, updates to training times, and other important news worthy items.

What We Prohibit

- Abuse towards others
- Exposing members to content that is offensive or inappropriate
- Abuse, harass or threaten the Wangaratta and District Cricket Association (WDCA), umpires, or members at any other club
- Make defamatory comments
- Use obscene, offensive, insulting, provocative or hateful language
- Intrude upon the privacy of other members without consent
- Comment in a way that may be construed as harming the reputation of him or herself, another member of WMCC or the WDCA, Committee members, umpires, and sponsors

Consequences

Minor breaches of this policy by members of WMCC will be given a warning and asked to explain why they should continue to be a member of the site. The WMCC Committee shall decide based on this reply.

Repeated or major breaches of this policy will see the person or persons brought before the WMCC Committee for bringing the game and/or the WMCC into disrepute, and following this, may be subject to bans or suspensions.
